iddle school students are likely among the most self-conscious people on the planet. The tiniest blemish seems like a major deformity, and they can consider any irregularity a fatal flaw. As a parent, it's sometimes hard to determine when surgical intervention is appropriate. When Andi Williams' little girl was a baby, somebody said she looked like a sugar bowl because of the way her ears protruded. And when her daughter, Kate, started middle school, Andi and her husband decided it was time to give Kate the option of surgery. "Being a girl today can be difficult—she was so shy and self-conscious, and she has to wear her hair up a lot because she's a dancer. We decided that surgery was within reason," explains Andi.

Kate, not comfortable with needles, pondered the option for more than a year before deciding to consult with a surgeon. Meanwhile she started wearing a headband at night in hopes that would press her ears back and prevent them from protruding through her hair.

Eventually she scheduled an appointment with Dr. William Silver, CEO and founder of Premier Image Cosmetic & Laser Surgery, and Kate says he set her at ease immediately. Otoplasty or ear surgery usually takes about two to three hours and is performed as an outpatient procedure with little post-operative discomfort and a quick recovery time of about a week. "I fashion a protective bandage for the patient to wear the first few days," Silver adds.

Otoplasty is a sculpturing technique performed with surgical instruments. It is always good to get a referral when considering corrective ear surgery. However, you still need to qualify the surgeon's credentials. Make sure he/she is a board certified facial plastic and reconstructive surgeon with a considerable amount of experience in Otoplasty.

It has been two years since the surgery, and Kate says she's definitely glad she had it done. "I can wear my hair any style I want, and my self-confidence has been boosted enormously."

Andi confirms, "Kate is a lot more confident and outgoing, now. We're so glad we decided to have this surgery."

"Otoplasty is one of the most rewarding procedures a facial plastic surgeon performs," confirms Silver. "The real joy comes in having the patients see the dramatic results immediately.


